Financial Matters

a. Report for the month

Current Account at 31 January: £7448.28 Business Reserve Account: £117.70

The Council has received from SCC a Community Pride grant to the value of £1500. This is directed at improvements to the village pond, and to the wildflower meadow. Cllr Bill Barker was thanked for his involvement in obtaining this grant for East Clandon.

b. Concurrent Functions Grant Aid.

The up-to date schedule of our CFG status was discussed. There is grant money available until 31st March 2014 to the sum of £500 for our Wildlife Habitat Improvements category. Further saplings will be purchased for the hedging across Tunmore Fields (first plantings carried out in early 2013). £1063 is also available for the Recreation Ground. Improvements to the playground were discussed and it was decided that new matting was needed for the areas under the swings.
