- 15/051 **Disclosures of Pecuniary Interest.** None
- 15/052 **Minutes of the meeting of Wednesday 1st April 2015.**
The Minutes were signed by the Chairman as a correct record.
- 15/053 Matters arising, not dealt with below as separate agenda items
Item 038/a. War memorial. Ongoing.
Item 038/e Risk Assessments. Follow-ups to be discussed at next meeting of the council.
Item 038/f. Ride London 2015. To be discussed as necessary at council meeting in June.
Item 038/g. Memorial to Captain Grenfell. Clare has been told by GBC that the issue has been resolved. It was decided to wait and see what action GBC will be taking.
Item 15/043. Proposed Village Party. To be discussed in June.
Item 15/044. Litter and dog poo bins. Mary has been in contact with GBC. Individual poobins are provided by GBC at a cost of £300 each, with a once-monthly emptying charge of £300 per year. It was decided that this is not a serious enough issue to warrant the expense. Al will liaise with other Snelgate residents about the suggested necessity of a general litter bin at the end of Snelgate, and will also monitor the situation.
Item 046 i. Rights of Way: Sawpit Lane access to Hatchlands. Sibylla is waiting to hear from Alex Bush (the newly appointed Administrator at Hatchlands) if any decision has been made.
Item 15/048. A246 safety at New Road Junction. Sibylla has been assured by SCC Highways that improvements are at “the top of the agenda”. This will be monitored.

Presentation of the draft (un-audited) accounts for the financial year to 31st March 2015. Accepted by the council as ready for formal approval at the Annual Meeting (following).
- 15/055 **Improvements to the fencing around the Common.**
