- b)DT asked if the Planning Applications email to the village could just be sent as the original email from GBC rather than transposing the information on a separate email. It was agreed so long as the Portal to view the applications was available to all.
- c) SCC Cllr Julie Iles – Major milestones in the county including COVID 19 Cases coming down. Schools are back and Lateral Flow tests are happening with Over 16 given Symptom free tests as well. Surrey Heartlands have administered over 500,000 jabs including 2nd jabs. Epsom Vaccination centre moving to Sandown Park.
South facing Slip Roads on the A3 decision is ongoing with a deadline of May 12th.
SCC are introducing an HGV Speedwatch on certain routes in the county. Monitoring and feedback to be available.
Cutting back the vegetation on the A246 footpaths has been given a new Log No. and SCC have agreed to escalate the issue.
Government guidelines have indicated that Councils should not have remote meetings after May 7th 2021. Julie reported that there has been a challenge to this and will further clarify.
There will be targeted activity to stop and check motorbikes for 1 month by the local SCC Inspector re Noise/Speed issues on the A246. IP suggested that an average speed camera (ASC) installed on the dual carriageway would deter motorbikes displaced by ASC's at Boxhill.
